Community Compost

- Initially concentrate on collecting organic matter at shoppe
- Community compost available for use for 2 Hands members/community garden/Youth Program garden
- 50 bags = 1 cubic yard; Collect leaf bags from neighborhoods

Social Activities

- Volunteer Work Days: Working on members personal gardens, collective garden, & compost
- Workshops: Members have requested Canning, soap & cheese making, & intro to vegetable gardening
- Pot Lucks: Socializing without sweating!

- Excess you sell at market

10% of produce for market

Personal Gardens

Volunteer Days: work on personal gardens / 2 Hands collective garden/compost

2 Hands Personal/Collective Gardens

- Personal Garden*: Your home garden
 - 10% veggies given to 2 Hands
 - Volunteer at 4 farmer's markets
 - Farmer's Market; by-product
 - See Volunteer requirements*

- 2 Hand Collective Garden Plot: Communal plot; growing veggies for food bank & market (spring)

Community Compost

Volunteers collect leaves & scraps / Members get/access to compost for personal/community garden
